Description: Standing, supported on a knotted branch, is he dressed in a wide robe, over which he wears a leaf collar and apron. Although the carver did not remove much of the triangular piece of the precious material, he succeeded in creating a powerfully expressive netsuke. This is particularly evident in the soft folds of the garment and the upward-looking face as well as in the long, curled hair in the neck.
