The monkey sits on the column and eats another apple, which it has taken from the bowl in front of it. At the feet of the goddess a putto as allegorical device, with soup bowl. On the pedestal a piece of ham and

in a rocaille a mouth.

Mark: Swords mark, painted blue under glaze.
